

EQiS™ OPEN TRAINING

Learn the skills and techniques for managing data workflows with EarthSoft's Environmental Quality Information System (EQiS) in this EQiS Open Training. Gain experience working with environmental analytic data, specifically focusing on workflows for importing and reporting data with EQiS.

The Training will center around reporting with EQiS Professional, EQiS Enterprise and importing data with the EQiS Data Processor (EDP), and well as sample planning with the EQiS Sample Planning Module (SPM) and field data collection with EDGE. Discussion will also include critical data management principles and practices such as:

- Developing standard operating procedures for data management and collection best practices
- Storing coordinates and other data in EQiS for maps and graphics
- Building and maintaining Groups and Action Levels in EQiS

This Training includes:

- Two (2) hours of online introductory content, July 7, 2017
- Three (3) days of in-person instruction, July 18-20, 2017
- Two (2) hours of online follow-up, July 28, 2017

This EarthSoft Training is recommended as an introductory Training for beginner-level or as refresher Training for intermediate-level EQiS end users.
