This Addendum to the Dry Cleaner Engineering Services is issued to provide clarifications by making changes and/or additions to the Request for Qualifications (RPQ).

**Changes and/or additions in the RFQ:**

The following section has been revised to read as follows:

**26. TEXAS ENVIRONMENTAL DATA SYSTEM (TEDS) INTEGRATION**

TEDS Data Submittal: Submit environmental field data to the Texas Environmental Data System (TEDS) using the EQuIS Data Gathering Engine (EDGE) software utility to electronically collect field data and export the data as an EDGE Electronic Data Deliverable (EDD) MS Excel file to load into the EQuIS Data Processor (EDP) software utility for submission to the TEDS. The field data to be loaded includes, but is not limited to, well locations, boring locations, other type sample locations, and other analytical results gathered in the field. Submit qualified lab analytical results and other required environmental data to the TEDS using the TEDS EDD MS Excel file to load the data into the EQuIS Data Processor (EDP) software utility and submit the data to the TEDS.

Additional Information Regarding 26-1: The first time the submission of environmental data using EDGE and EDP are required in a Work Order, the Contractor shall perform a onetime procedure to register as a data submitter user on the TEDS Enterprise website (<https://teds.tceq.texas.gov/>) and setup electronic submission of environmental data by downloading, from the web site, the EDGE and the EDP software utilities. The Contractor must also download, from the web site, the latest TEDS EDD format and the latest EDGE format to use when inputting data into the EDGE and the EDP. The Contractor will use the EDP application to create a blank TCEQ TEDS EDD MS Excel file whenever a new one is needed for loading data. Before submitting data for a site, the Contractor must verify that it has the latest versions of the EGDE format and the TEDS EDD format.
