



EQulS on California SLP Contract

February 2019 — EarthSoft announces California General Services has approved EQulS software and implementation services for inclusion in the Software Licensing Program (SLP) to streamline procurement of EQulS software for environmental data management. Several California government agencies use EQulS to manage various types of environmental sample data. This SLP contract is available for State of California departments and any city, county, special district, educational agency, local government body or corporation empowered to expend public funds.

The Software Licensing Program was established in January 1994 and is administered by the Department of General Services, Procurement Division. Extensive software discounts are negotiated with major software publishers that are then passed on to the State, through the SLP contracts established with authorized participating re-sellers.

While the state makes this contract available, each local agency should make its own determination whether the SLP is consistent with their procurement policies and regulations. The SLP Contractor is required to provide all SLP and the Software License Agreement contract terms and conditions with the list of products, services and prices. The most current ordering instructions and terms and conditions are included herein.

EQulS significantly improves environmental data quality with improved workflows for sample planning, data collection with smart forms on tablets, chain of custody management, electronic data checking, GIS and EnviroInsight integration, and integration with other specific decision support and data analysis software. EQulS EDD formats are used by several US state and federal agencies and all major commercial labs in the US and Canada have EarthSoft's EDP software.
